Academic Profile 2016-2017

EUGENE COMMUNITY:

Eugene is the second largest city in Oregon with a population of 163,460, while the Eugene/Springfield metro area has a population of 351,794. Nearby institutions of higher learning are: University of Oregon, Northwest Christian University, Pacific University (satellite), New Hope Christian College, and Lane Community College. Eugene is home to world-renowned forests and rivers, bike and running trails, the NCAA and Olympic track trials, and the historic Hayward Field.

SHELDON COMMUNITY:

Sheldon is one of the four area high schools in the Eugene 4j School District. Our high school is a four-year comprehensive school with yearly enrollment of approximately 1,488. (Sept. 2016). We are accredited by the Northwest Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges. Sheldon has an FTE of 51.63, and 100% of our teachers are Highly Qualified.

CURRENT TRIMESTER BLOCK SCHEDULE BEGAN SEPTEMBER 2013:

Beginning in the September 2013-2014 academic year, the Eugene 4j School District, including Sheldon High School, has been on a Trimester BLOCK schedule. This means there are three terms of 12 weeks with five periods a day (70-minute classes). Every trimester, each class is worth .5 credit; most core courses require 1.0 credit total. A student can potentially earn 7.5 credits in a year. A high school diploma in Oregon requires 24 credits; however, a student in the honors program must earn 25 credits.

PAST 4x4 BLOCK:

Ending with the Class of 2013, Sheldon High School was on a 4x4 Block schedule. This meant that there were four terms of nine weeks with 83-minute classes, in which every course was .5 credit. Core classes required 1.0 credit. The schedule consisted of four classes per day. A student typically earned 8.0 credits in an academic year.

INTERNATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL (IHS), INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) AND SPANISH

IMMERSION (SI): IHS is a rigorous college preparatory school that emphasizes a study of history and cultures. Students are required to take three years of a world language, write a 3500-4000 word extended essay research paper, and complete 150 hours of Creativity, Action, and Service to meet IHS graduation requirements. IHS classes meet on an A-B-C rotation schedule for the entire school year. Across 11th and 12th grades, students have the option of working toward the International Baccalaureate Diploma by completing coursework and taking comprehensive examinations in six subject areas. Students who are also enrolled in the Spanish Immersion (SI) program take four years of Spanish Literature/Composition courses and Spanish-language content courses when offered. Entry to IHS is through the 4J School Choice lottery.

HONORS:

The Honors Program requires additional reading, writing and research in the Language Arts. Courses in grades 9 and 10 are designated as honors on the transcript. Students have the option of enrolling in honors level coursework in language arts, social studies, or both. Typically, students enrolled in honors courses will be well prepared to transition to Advanced Placement (AP) courses in junior and senior years.

EUGENE 4j DIPLOMA SEAL:

In order to graduate with the Eugene 4j Diploma Seal, students must have a 3.5 cumulative GPA at graduation, 25 high school credits, and complete 120 hours of documented community service.

COMMON GROUND:

While language arts (LA) and social science (SS) areas are program specific to IHS and Honors, areas of math (MA), science (SC) and world language (AF) are not designated IHS or Honors until advanced levels are attained. Then courses may be AP or IB or CN or may be designated AP/IB/CN (College Now - see category below).

COLLEGE NOW (CN):

College Now (51 courses) is a program through Lane Community College (LCC) and Linn-Benton Community College

(LBCC) for students who are interested in taking college classes offered at Sheldon High School. Credit is awarded to those students who earn a “B” or better in any of the following courses. Furthermore, instructors are community college approved. See list below for class names that are both high school credit and college credit.
